

# TRENDY TEENS OF METAVERSE 2025

## General Rules

1. Trendy Teens consists of Science Quiz and three competitions namely:
  - I. Dancing Star
  - II. Singing Idol
  - III. Best Orator
  - IV. Grandmaster Chess
2. Students can participate in any number of competitions. For every competition, students will have to register separately.
3. Dancing Star, Singing Idol and 10 minutes Chess competition are the two competitions in which you may perform **SOLO or in GROUP**. The Group can contain a maximum of 15 members.
4. Students may register through registration link or even offline application form. The link can be accessed in two ways:
  - a) Clicking on the given link <https://christcollegerajkot.edu.in/event-registration/NDg2>
  - b) Scanning the QR Code given below



5. Registration fees for each student per event will be **Rs. 100/-**. After the successful registration, a registration code will be generated which will be used for all further communication.
6. Registration will be exclusively on **first come first** basis.
- 7. Quiz will be in English as well as Gujarati language.**
- 8.** On the day of the event students must bring valid ID proof as mentioned in the registration form along with transaction ID.
- 9.** During the event, participants will have to follow the rules of the respective competitions. Violation of which may result in disqualification of the participants.
- 10.** **The Judgment of the Jury Panel shall be considered final and binding.**
- 11.** Winners of every competition (**Solo**) shall be awarded a **WINNING TROPHY, CASH PRIZE** and a Certificate.
- 12.** Winners of every competition (**Group**) shall be awarded a **WINNING TROPHY, CASH PRIZE**. Medals and a Certificate for each participant.
- 13.** **Runner up** of every competition shall be awarded with a **TROPHY**.
- 14.** **For the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Position of Quiz, GOLD and SILVER medals will be awarded respectively.**
- 15.** **All the participants shall additionally also avail the benefit of SCHOLARSHIP provided by CHRIST CAMPUS at the time of admission as per the CAMPUS Policy.**
- 16.** **Registration fees will not be refunded, if any participant found disqualified for any reason during the event.**

# Quiz Rules

## TERMS & CONDITIONS

### **Eligibility:**

1. School students of classes 9<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> only (of any education board) are eligible to participate in the Quiz.
2. One team will consist of two students. If one member of the team remains absent due to any reason on the day of competition, the team will be disqualified without refunding registration fees.
3. Combination of one student from Junior category and one student of Senior category will be allowed.

### **Rounds:**

1. All registered teams will be eligible to take part in **Round 1** of the **Quiz**.
2. Round 1 will be the ***Elimination Round***.
3. Elimination Round will consist of 30 questions in Multiple Choice Question (MCQ) Format. Questions will be related to Current Affairs, History, Geography, Sports, Films, Information technology, Language, Indian Constitution, etc.
4. 30 mins will be given for attempting the questions.
5. Marks up scheme will be as follows:  
(+4) – correct answer  
(-1) – incorrect answer  
(0) – not attempted
6. In case of tie at any stage of the quiz, there will be a tie-breaker test between the teams with the same score.
7. Once a team completes **Round 1**, results will be declared within 30 mins.
8. Top 5 teams each from Junior Category and Senior Category will be eligible for **Round 2,3 and 4** of the **QUIZ**.
9. For any dispute or conflict, the decision of the Quiz Master shall be final and binding to all.

1. This is an individual event.
2. The speech is intended to reveal a competitor's ability to develop a point of view on a general topic and to deliver within limited preparation time.
3. A list of topics is provided underneath:
  - I. Atmanirbhar Bharat.
  - II. Social media is making as unsocial.
  - III. Co-curricular activities boost overall development.
  - IV. The climate change problem.
  - V. Plastic free life.
  - VI. Goal setting is important for success.
  - VII. Importance of value education.
  - VIII. Technology has made life better.
  - IX. Tourism boosts local economy.
  - X. Benefits of Ayurveda.
4. You may choose any **ONE** topic and prepare for your speech.
5. Each participant will be given **5 minutes** to speak on a topic picked up by him or her.
6. Participant can speak either in English, Hindi or Gujarati.
7. Points like clarity of thought, logical organization, sincerity and the effective use of plain language shall be kept in mind while preparing the speech.
8. Participants will be judged on the following criteria:
  - ✓ *Appearance*
  - ✓ *Body Language*
  - ✓ *Persuasiveness*
  - ✓ *Clear presentation of ideas*
9. To register participant will have to fill up the online registration form and pay registration fees of Rs 100 after which a registration code would be generated.
10. Participant must carry any one of the original and valid Photo Identification Proof issued by the government" – PAN card/Driving License/Voter ID/12th Class Board Admit or Registration card/ Passport/ Aadhaar Card (With photograph)/ E-Aadhaar/ Ration Card./ Aadhaar Enrolment No. with Photo.

## SINGING IDOL-SOLO

1. This is a solo competition.
2. The participant can select songs in English, Hindi or Gujarati.
3. The participant may choose semi-classical, light vocal, devotional or Bollywood songs. The participant can have maximum *two accompanists* if required viz. harmonium, keyboard, tabla, guitar, etc.
4. If the participants need accompanist, the details of the accompanist must be given during the registration.  
Note: There won't be any registration fees for the accompanists.
5. The participant will have to bring their musical track in a pen drive and also keep a backup if the participant chooses to perform with karaoke.
6. The time limit for each participant is **maximum 3 minutes**.
7. The criteria for judgment are:
  - ✓ *Sur/ Melody*
  - ✓ *Rhythm*
  - ✓ *Song Selection*
  - ✓ *Overall Presentation*
8. To register participant will have to fill up the online registration form and pay registration fees of Rs 100 after which a registration code would be generated.

## SINGING IDOL – GROUP

1. This is a **group** competition.
2. A group can have a maximum of 15 participants along with accompanists, if any, and a minimum of 2 participants.
3. The participants can select songs in English, Hindi or Gujarati.
4. They may choose semi-classical, light vocal, devotional or Bollywood songs. The participant can have maximum *two accompanists* if required viz. harmonium, keyboard, tabla, guitar, etc.
5. If the participants need accompanist, the details of the accompanist must be given during the registration.  
Note: There won't be any registration fees for the accompanists.
6. The participants will have to bring their musical track in a pen drive and also keep a backup if the participant chooses to perform with karaoke.
7. The time limit for the group performance is **maximum 5 minutes**.
8. The tentative criteria for judgment are:
  - ✓ *Sur/ Melody*
  - ✓ *Rhythm*
  - ✓ *Song Selection*
  - ✓ *Overall Presentation*
10. To register participant will have to fill up the online registration form and pay registration fees of Rs 100 after which a registration code would be generated.
11. Participant must carry any one of the original and valid Photo Identification Proof issued by the government” – PAN card/Driving License/Voter ID/12th Class Board Admit or Registration card/ Passport/ Aadhaar Card (With photograph)/ E-Aadhaar/ Ration Card./ Aadhaar Enrolment No. with Photo.

## **BEST DANCER SOLO**

1. This is a **solo** competition.
2. The time limit for the dance performance is **maximum 3 minutes**.
3. The participant will have to bring their musical/dance track in a pen drive and also keep a backup.
4. The costumes should be befitting our cultural decency and their expense should be borne by the respective individual. If a costume is not found appropriate (no short length, sleeveless costumes, etc.), the participant can be disqualified.
5. Props to facilitate the dance performance are allowed but not any weapon, gulal or any material that makes the place untidy.
6. The judgment criteria would be:
  - ✓ *Choreography*
  - ✓ *Coordination*
  - ✓ *Expression and*
  - ✓ *Overall Impact*
7. To register participant will have to fill up the online registration form and pay registration fees of Rs 100 after which a registration code would be generated.
8. Participant must carry any one of the original and valid Photo Identification Proof issued by the government” – PAN card/Driving License/Voter ID/12th Class Board Admit or Registration card/ Passport/ Aadhaar Card (With photograph)/ E-Aadhaar/ Ration Card./ Aadhaar Enrolment No. with Photo.

## **BEST DANCER - GROUP**

1. This is a **group** competition.
2. A group shall have a minimum of 2 participants and can have a maximum of 15 participants.
3. The time limit for the dance performance is minimum 3 minutes and **maximum 5 minutes.**
4. The selected participants will have to bring their musical/dance track in a pen drive and also keep a backup.
5. The costumes should be befitting our cultural decency and their expense should be borne by the respective individual or team. If a costume is not found appropriate (no short length, sleeveless costumes, etc.), the group can be disqualified.
6. Props to facilitate the dance performance are allowed but not any weapon, gulal or any material that makes the place untidy.
7. The judgment criteria would be:
  - ✓ *Choreography*
  - ✓ *Coordination*
  - ✓ *Expression and*
  - ✓ *Overall Impact*
8. To register participant will have to fill up the online registration form and pay registration fees of Rs 100 after which a registration code would be generated.
9. Participant must carry any one of the original and valid Photo Identification Proof issued by the government” – PAN card/Driving License/Voter ID/12th Class Board Admit or Registration card/ Passport/ Aadhaar Card (With photograph)/ E-Aadhaar/ Ration Card./ Aadhaar Enrolment No. with Photo.

## Grandmaster - Chess

10-minute rapid chess is a popular time control because it allows players to think more deeply about their moves than in blitz chess, but it is still fast-paced enough to be exciting. It is a good choice for players who want to improve their chess skills without having to spend hours playing each game.

The rules of 10-minute rapid chess are the same as the rules of standard chess, with the following exceptions:

1. Each player has 10 minutes to complete the game.
2. Participants should install a chess timer clock in their mobile. And that timer clock will be used for the game.
3. The game is won by checkmate, resignation, or the expiration of the time on one player's clock.
4. If both players' clocks expire at the same time, the game is a draw.
5. En passant rule is applicable for pawns. The rule ensures that a pawn cannot use its two-square move to safely skip past an enemy pawn.
6. Players are not allowed to make any illegal moves.
7. Players are not allowed to touch any of the pieces on the board except for the piece they are moving. Touching a piece means, the player has to move the same piece.
8. Players are not allowed to make any unnecessary delays.
9. Players are not allowed to communicate with each other during the game.
10. Use your time wisely. Don't spend too much time on each move, but don't rush either.
11. Look for tactical opportunities. In 10-minute rapid chess, there is less time for positional play, so you need to be more aggressive and look for ways to win material or checkmate your opponent.
12. Be aware of the clock. Don't let your time run out!
13. Practice regularly. The more you play, the better you will get at playing 10-minute rapid chess.
14. No separate competition for girls and boys, it will be combined competition.
