1. International Yoga Day celebration (21/6/24)

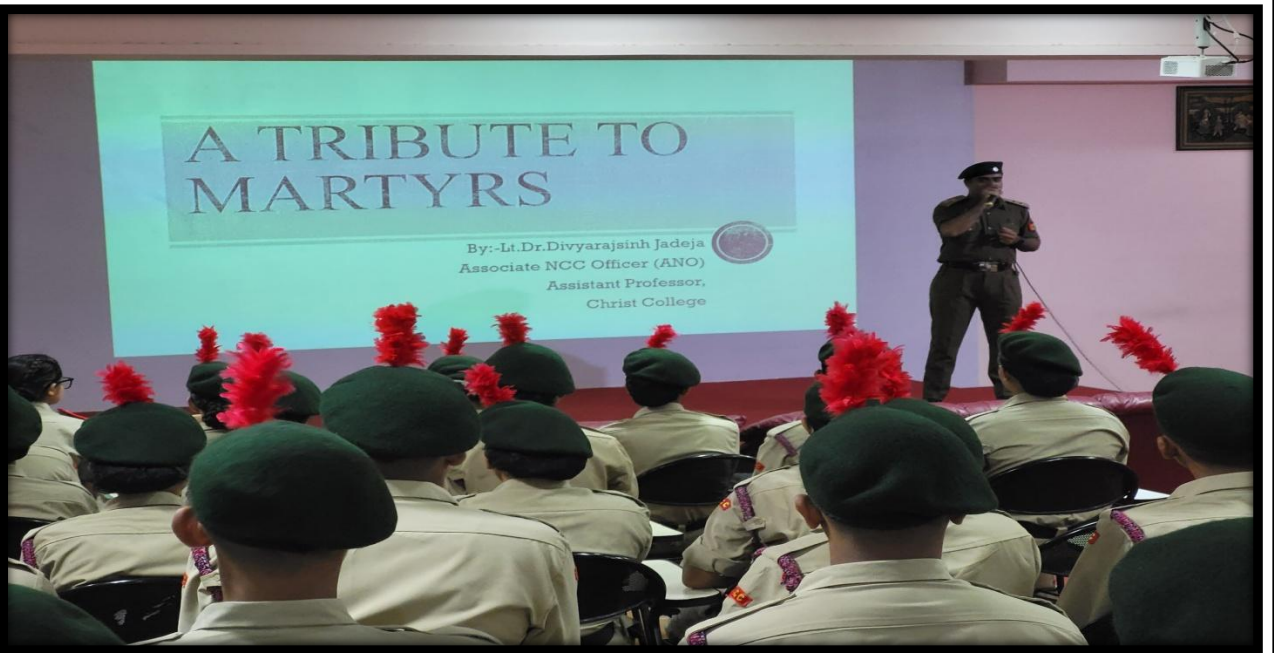
