GUIDELINES FOR PARTICIPANTS

- 1. Participant's eligibility: Pursuing any Under Graduate and Post Graduate course.
- 2. Last date for registration & payment is 12th September, 2025. Registration Fee for Participants is Rs. 200 per participant. Participants can register in up to 3 events.
- 3. Individual registration is compulsory along with offline payment.
- 4. A student can register in maximum 3 events, depending on the time schedule. (Kindly refer the detailed time schedule given in this rule book). If there is clash in the events for which the participant has registered, he/she will be allowed to participate in one event only, and the registration fees will not be refunded.
- 5. Participants are not allowed to change the names of team members in any case.
- 6. Entries are limited and considered on First-Come, First-Served Basis.
- 7. Kindly refer the rules of individual games for team formation. Teams not formed as per mentioned rules will be disqualified.
- 8. All participants have to carry their **Institute Identity card**.
- 9. Change in any rule will be highlighted or communicated before the start of event.
- 10. In case of any discrepancies or disputes, decision of organizing committee will be final and binding to all. The decision of the judges will remain final.
- 11. Transportation (within Rajkot city) will be provided on prior intimation.

GUIDELINES FOR PARTICIPANTS FROM OTHER THAN GUJARAT

- 1. There will be 2 phases of participation. Phase 1 will be online elimination round on 13th September, 2025.
- 2. Certificates will be given to all participants of phase 1.
- 3. Special Rewards will be given to all those who will represent their State in phase 2 (actual day of Chrizellenz Season 7) on Christ campus, Rajkot.
- 4. Certificates for participants and Winners will be given. In addition to this, special awards and attractive prizes will be given to all winners.

INSTA CLICK - SPOT PHOTOGRAPHY (Individual Participation)

- The participant has to bring his/her own digital camera.
- The digital camera should have a memory card which will be formatted by the judges before the commencement of the contest.
- The time limit will be 2 hours.
- The participant has to capture 5 photographs on the theme announced on the spot by the judges.
- No mixing, matching or morphing of photographs will be permitted. Use of AI is also prohibited in any form.
- Software such as Photoshop etc. for enhancing images not permitted.
- The organizers will have all rights for the use of these pictures as and when they deem fit.
- Digital images are evaluated on the basis of (i) impact (ii) composition (iii) technical quality and (iv) suitability for the specific theme.

- 10 topics will be given for preparation. Selection of topic will be on the basis of draw for each team. The team has to speak on that given topic in the event.
- Each Team will be allowed to speak for maximum 5 minutes in the Competition.
- The sequence of speakers will be decided by a draw of lots.

Round 1:

- This is an elimination round. Round 2:
- Extempore [2 minutes speech on a topic given on the spot. The topics will be relevant to Geo-Socio-Politics]
- Topics will be allotted through drawing lots. Round 3:
- Debate Round. The participants will be given a topic and there will be a quick debate of 5 minutes for
 each topic between two participants. A toss will decide which participant gets to choose side of the
 debate.
- Topics will be allotted through drawing lots
- Elimination will be done after this round again.
- The cumulative scores of rounds 2 and 3 will be considered for the elimination.
- Those who get eliminated will be allowed to participate in the competitions scheduled after lunch break

Round 4 [Grand Finale]:

- It will be a stress interview round with 2 judges in the panel for interview.
- Cumulative scores of the two individuals across all the rounds will be considered in the final calculation.
- Individual with the maximum points at the end of this round including the panel interview will be crowned the Corporate Chanakya 2025.
