

Report outreach program by Chemistry

The Department of Chemistry at Christ College, Rajkot, organized an outreach program for Premier School students to educate them on the concept of food adulteration, its health implications, and how to identify adulterated food. Through a PowerPoint presentation, students learned about common food adulterants, their effects, and the difference between intentional and unintentional adulteration. Practical tips and simple home methods, such as using iodine solution or water, were demonstrated to test for food purity. The session also covered food safety regulations and the role of government bodies in ensuring quality. An interactive Q&A session followed, where students engaged by asking questions and sharing personal experiences. They were encouraged to raise awareness about food adulteration within their communities.
