

Rules for Member

1. The member of CHL must be respectful in their questions and conversation with the Human Book.
2. It should be acceptable that the Human Book can quit the conversation if they feel that the Reader is treating them in an inappropriate or disrespectful manner.
3. As member we should make sure that during sessions, the reader cannot record, videotape or picture should be taken with prior permission with human book or organisers.
4. The member should not ask the Human Book for personal contact information. All requests for further contact should be through the CHL organizers.
5. Your membership of the CHL is principally life long, but it is in within your right, at any time to leave. You also have the right to object or to get the information deleted, if you no longer wish to be a part of the CHL.
6. CHL organisers have all rights to remove your membership if any discrepancy found

Ground rules for participant behavior:

- Treat other participants with dignity, respect, care, and courtesy at all times.
- Be careful about usage of verbal language or physical gestures during the CHL event.
- Do not express or act on the very prejudices and stereotypes that the CHL seeks to dispel
- Remember that participants are expressing their own personal viewpoints. No one member of a group can speak for all the other members.
- Be careful and sensitive when using humour - not everyone may get the joke. Check-in with people to confirm they are ok with humour, teasing, jokes, etc., particularly if they are looking uncomfortable.
- It is open discussion, avoid recruitment
- Do not take advantage of inside knowledge of the particular vulnerabilities of sensitive human book
- No threatening or intimidating behaviour towards others, whether physical, verbal or psychological.
- Do not deliberately give offense to another participant.
- If you find something offensive during discussion -- it may be unintended or accidental. Get it clarified amicably.
